As a club with the University of Arizona Alumni Association, the University of Arizona Black Alumni (UABA) was formed in 1983 with a focus to promote higher education opportunities for African American students in Arizona at the University of Arizona and to provide networking opportunities through the Scholarship Endowment program. UABA welcomes your application for financial aid. Please read and complete the Scholarship Application carefully. Take into consideration that this application is the only means of evaluating your qualifications. To be considered for a UABA scholarship, you must meet the requirements and submit (a) a typed, one-page *personal statement* on the topic, **“Has the African American Neighborhood Vanished? What Are The Effects of Gentrification?”**; (b) a high school and/or college transcript(s); (c) a completed application and (d) a letter of recommendation to the UABA Black Alumni Scholarship Committee no later than **December 16 at 5:00 p.m.**

Purpose: Selection is based on financial need and other factors such as academic performance for any student. *Financial aid may consist of a renewable tuition scholarship or a one-time cash award and/or book scholarship.*

Requirements:

1. Completed application must be received by **December 16** every year.
2. Demonstrated level of commitment to the African American community.
3. Must be Arizona residents.
4. Must be legally able to attend the University.
5. Must perform community service on and off campus within the African American community.
6. Must be enrolled as a full-time student (minimum of 12 units per semester) at the University of Arizona for the academic year for which financial aid is being sought.

Note: The UABA scholarships cannot be awarded in conjunction with any other tuition waiver received by an applicant. One-time scholarship award amounts may vary. Waivers are for University of Arizona tuition only. Recipients will be notified of their awards by letter. Incomplete applications or those received after the deadline will not be considered. If granted a UABA scholarship, you must maintain a 2.50 cumulative grade average. You will be monitored throughout the year and will be notified at the end of the spring semester of your scholarship status. Scholarship recipients are required to notify the UA Black Alumni of address/e-mail updates and attend a mandatory orientation sponsored by UABA. If you accept an award, you will be expected to participate with UABA activities. Incoming freshmen are encouraged to apply to the UA New Start Program. You may call the Department of Multicultural Programs and Services (520) 621.1094 for further information. Incoming freshmen are *required* to participate with a transitional academic program such as M.E.R.I.T (Maximum Education Results in Two Semesters) during their freshmen year.
